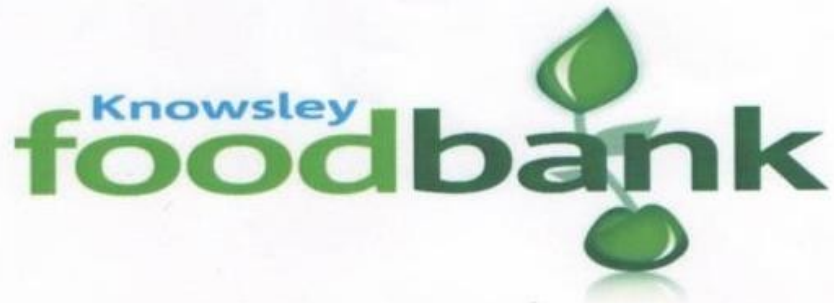

DAY of PRAYER Wed 9th Sept

Hi there - I have attached a letter to everyone about joining in with another 24-1 day of prayer. I always get excited when the church sets aside time to pray because I know things start to happen. So please do get back to me with any slots you can do.

24-1 prayer - 9th -10th September

We are encouraging everyone across the Haleswood and Hunts Cross team to set aside time to pray together. We could say that there are many reasons to pray, some of which will be listed below. However, the call to prayer comes initially out of desire simply to draw close to God. Our first call as the people of God is to worship, and so whenever we join to pray our focus needs to be directed to God and not the problems. We pray to 'Our Father in Heaven' asking that his name is 'Hallowed' - ie honoured worshipped and praised.

I do not believe there is any more exciting adventure in life than meeting with the living God, in the words of Jesus - "This is eternal life that they may know the one true God and Jesus Christ whom you have sent" John 17 v 3

So can I encourage you to carve out space in that 24 hour period to pray. You may like to pray for 15 minutes, but if you have done that before think about whether you might extend that to 30 minutes. We need to make 'baby steps' in our faith so that we continue to grow and not slack off in our pursuit of God and in our response to follow Jesus. Time slots will start from 8.30pm on Wednesday evening and continue for every quarter hour until 8.30pm the next day.

Of course there are things that we need a miracle for, at this time ! There are those who we know and love who are unwell and our financial situation needs improving. We also want to pray for our churches as they open up again, and that the lessons we have learnt during lockdown will remain with us. So please reply, letting me know which slot(s) you would like to do.
